As above, Universities / societies shall not register excess number of students than sanctioned university-wise, class-wise numbers under N.S.S., in this scheme. Also, for the year 2015-2016 class-wise number of students it be distributed amongst the concerned.

Each University / Society shall class-wise distribute number of students distributed to them amongst the colleges related with them.

Each University / Society shall class-wise distribute number of students distributed to them amongst the colleges related with them and submit its copy to the Government. Universities shall inform upto 30<sup>th</sup> September, 2015 the number of students actually registered.

Said Government resolution is made available on the website of Government of Maharashtra Government bearing No. www/maharashtra.gov.in., and its code number is 201506301522023108. This order is issued after making digital signature.

#### **Special Camp Activity**

Special Camp (2015-16)

The NSS Special Camp activity carried out in village Khubi, of Karad taluka from 1<sup>st</sup> to 7<sup>th</sup> March, 2016. Following are day-to-day review of the Camp.

Day 1 (March 1, 2016): Student volunteers and Staff started to Khubi by 8:30am and reached Khubi by 9:30am. Sarpanch Mr. Vijayrao Jagatap (Bhau), Deputy Sarpanch Mr. Kuber Mane (Appa), other members of Grampanchayat and villagers welcomed us all. After putting the material; students prepared and marched for 'Shivar Pheri' to alert villagers regarding initiation of the Camp. On return they all gathered in the temple, nearby the school building which was given us to stay. They were introduced the survey forms. Everyone's queries and doubts about survey were cleared. By 11:00 they started the survey and returned back around 1:00pm. At 2:30pm team of doctors lead by Dr Sujata Patil and Dr Shekhar Kumbhar arrived at Camp stay place for School Health Checkup programme. Between 3:00 to 5:00pm health checkup for 1st to 7th standard children was carried out. Total 94 children were checked. They all were given dewormingtablets. Children with dental problems were informed to visit Dental and Oral Checkup programme on 3<sup>rd</sup> March, 2016 in Siddheshwar Temple between 3:00 to 5:00pm. The same was informed to concerned teachers and Head Mistress of the School. In the evening by 6:00pm the inaugural function of the NSS Special Camp was done. Mr. Sanjay Pawar; Ex Taluka Panchayat Member was the Chief Guest to inaugurate the Special Camp. Sarpanch Mr. Vijay Jagatap, Deputy Sarpanch Mr. Kuber (Appa) Mane, All Members of Khubi Grampanchayat, Mr Dhanaji (Kaka) Mane, Mr Sandip Mane, all

Day 2 (March 2. 2016): After discussion on experiences on the 1<sup>st</sup> day, students started the survey by 9:30am. Associate Programme co-ordinator Sheela Kadam, Programme Officers Dr Avinash Mane, Dr S. Anand, and Shivaji Pawar & Assistants Mr Rais Patel, Mr Dheeraj Mane, Mr Mahendra Alate, Mr Amit Patel, Mrs Seema Dhadachire (Medical Social Worker) and Mrs Rajashree Yadav (Staff Nurse) were visiting houses to guide students and to help students in recording BP, Glucose level, BMI etc. they returned back by 1:00pm. At 2:30pm team of doctors lead by Dr Sujata Patil and Dr Shekhar Kumbhar arrived at Camp stay place for School Health Checkup programme. Between 3:00 to 4:30pm healths checkup for 8<sup>th</sup>& 9<sup>th</sup> standard children was carried out. Total 36 children were checked.Children with dental problems were informed to visit Dental and Oral Checkup programme on 3<sup>rd</sup> March, 2016 in Siddheshwar Temple between 3:00 to

5:00pm. In the evening by 7:00pm the one act play 'Varhad Nighalay Landanla' demonstrated by Mr. Ramchandra Garud . Dr. Siddharth Gosavi, Professor Dept. of Prosthodontics, School of Dental Sciences, Karad was present as per our special invitation to attend this 'Awareness through Entertainment' programme. Student volunteers from Medical College managed this programme. However, after ½ an hour due to the change in the climate i.e. due to lightning, wind and rain the programme could not completed.

Day 3 (March 3. 2016): Similar to 2<sup>nd</sup> day, students started survey activity by 9:30am under supervision of the staff. They returned back by 1:00pm. By 2:30pm the team of dental doctors lead by Programme Officer Dr Keshav Abbayya arrived at the Camp place for 'Dental and Oral checkup' activity. 106 villagers of all age groups were checked in this Camp. Doctors gave free medicine to the needy. They also suggested them to visit Dental Hospital with the given card to get concession in the treatment. In the evening by 7:00pm speech on 'Chatrapati Sambhaji Raje' was delivered by Mr. Shankar Kulkarni. Dr. Rajkumar Patange, Professor and Head Dept. of Ob. Gyn., Krishna Hospital, Karad was present as per our special invitation to attend this 'Awareness through Entertainment' programme. Student volunteers from Physiotherapy College managed this programme. Our students and villagers found exited during the speech.

Day 4 (March 4. 2016): On 4<sup>th</sup> day also student went on survey by 9:30am and came back by 1:00pm. By 2:30pm the team of Physiotherapy doctors lead by Dr Praveen Gawali arrived at the Camp place. They conducted 'Physiotherapic treatment & guidance for heart and lung patients' and 'Physiotherapic treatment & guidance on bone and muscle abnormalities'. 53 villagers were checked in this Camp. Doctors taught them with required exercise to overcome their concerned health problem. In the evening by 7:00pm the speech on 'Swapnatun Satyakade' centered on the astrologer Late Kalpana Chawala delivered by Dr. Shantanu Kulkarni. Mrs. Sheela Kadam, Associate Programme Coordinator of NSS was the Chief Guest for this 'Awareness through Knowledge' programme. Student volunteers from Nursing College managed this programme. All were very happy as they got the information which they will not get in any book presently available on her in the market. This was the information acquired by Dr Santanu Kulkarni by personal discussion with parents of Kalpana Chawala.

Day 5 (March 5, 2016):On 5<sup>th</sup> day also student went on survey by 9:30am and came back by 1:00 pm. The majority work of village survey was completed. By 2:30pm the team of Obstetrician & Gynecologists lead by Dr Manisha Laddad arrived at the Camp place for 'Women Health Checkup' activity. 146 women were checked in this Camp. Mrs Sheela Kadam, Dr Avinash Mane, Mrs Seema Dhadachire (Medical Social Worker) and Mrs Rajashree Yadav (Staff Nurse) did counseling of women on their various health problems. In the evening by 7:00pm speech on 'Chatrapati Sambhaji Raje' was delivered by Mr. Shankar Kulkarni. Dr. Rajkumar Patange, Professor and Head Dept. of Ob. Gyn., Krishna Hospital, Karad was present as per our special invitation to attend this 'Awareness through Entertainment' programme. Student volunteers from Physiotherapy College managed this programme. Our students and villagers found exited during the speech.

Day 6 (March 6, 2016): On 6<sup>th</sup> day students completed the village survey activity. As per the calendar 7<sup>th</sup> March was the day of Mahashivaratri; the Camp was decided to conclude on 6<sup>th</sup> March. The valedictory function was arranged in Siddheshwar Temple. Retired Teacher Mr. Maruti Mane was the chief guest for the function. Mr Kuber Mane presided the function. Sarpanch and all members of Grampanchayat and villagers were present on this oocassion.

In all 50 NSS student volunteers from KIMS (20), SDS (10), KINS (10) and KCPT (10) Participated in the NSS Special Camp. They followed instructions and directions given time-to-time by the staff. During this period Mr Rais Patel conducted value based games: 1. how should be the friend; for survey pairs he asked experiences of right (good) and wrong (bad) approaches of his/her colleague during survey, 2. How to overcome obstacles; During survey how to develop rapport with the family members and how to simplify the survey activity and encourage them to provide the all information that to be filled in the survey form though anybody absent at the time of survey. Students interestingly understood these techniques.

All student volunteers and staff visited Sugar Factory, Rethare Budruk and the Ramling Bet located 5km away from khubi during leisure time. During Sugar Factory visit Safety Engineer Mr Dhekane took round of the students and explained the functioning since sugar cane carrying chain to filling of fine sugar in bags. Managing Director Mr. Jagadish Haralikar invited all for tea. He discussed with students on occupational hazards and needs of health care of factory workers. He felicitated all staff. On last day on the way of return we all visited Chourangnath Temple, situated on the top of hill near village Sonsal.

All students were very happy as they got different experiences in all ways. The staff was also very happy as they completed the Special Camp activity successfully and smoothly without any issue. Leaders of Khubi as well as Khubi villagers extended whole hearted cooperation in each activity.

#### **Special Camp (2016-17)**

The NSS Special Camp was carried out in village Khubi, of Karad taluka for second time from Feb. 27 to March 5, 2017. Fifty student volunteers from different disciplines (20 Medical, 10 Dental, 10 Nursing, and 10 Physiotherapy) participated in the Camp. They were informed about Camp activities in advance in their respective Institutes by their respective Programme Officer. Following is day-to-day activities done in the Camp.

Day 1 (Monday 27th Feb., 2017); Students and staff started to Khubi by 8:30am and reached by 9:30am. Sarpanch Mr Vijaybhau Jagatap, Dy. Sarpanch Kuberappa Mane, members of Khubi Grampanchayat, local leaders and villagers welcomed us all. Students, boys and girls, kept their material in allotted rooms and marched for 'Shivar-Pheri' to alert all villagers regarding initiation of the Camp activities by giving slogans and distributing programme schedule to villagers. On return they all gathered in Siddheshwar temple nearby the stay place. They were given tea and informed how to conduct the survey. They were also asked to keep discipline throughout the Camp. The groups each of 5 students were formed to conduct surveys on various topics viz. 1. Knowledge of organ donation, 2. Prevalence of hypertension, 3. Socio-clinical parameters and biological age, 4. Factors associated with low back pain and 5. Practice and knowledge about reproduction system in age group 12-16yrs; during seven days Camp period. As it was 12:00noon, students were asked just to initiate survey activity by filling at least 3-4 survey forms. The staff also accompanied students during the survey. They returned by 1:00pm. By the time lunch was ready. Students from Medical faculty served food to all. Students from Dental faculty prepared for 'Child Health Programme'. The team of doctors led by Pediatrician Dr. Vishal Patil arrived by 2:30pm for conduction of this activity. This team was assisted by Dental Students. The team checked 125 children and provided medicines as well as guided for further treatment to those needy. In the evening Dental students arranged for Camp Inauguration Programme. Registrar Dr M V Ghorapade and Professor Dr Asha Jadhav were present on this occasion. They were summarized the first day activities. Dr Ghorapade inaugurated the Camp. After inauguration they both visited

students rest place as well as food preparation place. During this visit they directed us about students' safety and care.

Day 2 (Tuesday 28th Feb., 2017): Survey conducted from 9:00am to 12:00noon. The second day lunch was sponsored by Mr. Blakrishna Sutar, the Khubi villager. He gave very good vegetarian food to the volunteers and the staff. Dental students served the food. During afternoon from 3:00pm to 6:00pm 'Women Health Programme' was carried out. The team of doctors led by Dr Manisha Laddad and Dr Vaishali Vhaval checked 137 women in the age group 0f 12-85years. Medical students assisted the team. In the evening One-Act play 'Varhad nighalay Londonla' was presented by Mr. Ramchandra Garud, the staff of KIMSDU working in Transport Department. Students, Staff and villagers enjoyed a lot. An arrangement of this programme was done by Physiotherapy students. Dr Sunita Tata, Director Nursing Services, KIMSDU was Chief Invitee for this evening programme. On this occasion she addressed students and villagers.

Day 3 (Wednesday 1st March, 2017): The survey activity was carried out as usual during 9:00am to 12:00noon. The survey of knowledge about organ donation was over as it was one person - one house survey and students not engaged in the afternoon health programme were doing survey work in the afternoon also. On Wednesday special lunch (feast) was given to all, students, staff and villagers (members of Gram-panchayat, local leaders and members of Ganesh Mandals). Nursing and Physiotherapy students served food. In the afternoon 'Dental Health Programme' was arranged and assisted by Dental students. Dr Zope and Dr Vishwajit Kale-Deshmukh led team of doctors for conducting this activity. Dental check up of 73 needy men and women was done. They were given required medicines and were also given cards to take advantage of free/concessional treatment during three months period since the card given, at Dental College, KIMSDU, Karad. The evening programme was especially for public awareness. Dr Nitin Shinde, Head Department of Physics, KBP College, Karad presented the lecture on 'Phal-Jyotish: Samaj aani Vastav' with aid of PPT. all were impressed by listening and understanding concepts and contents of his talk. It was found to be new to all. For this programme Dr Mrs Vaishali Mohite, Principal KINS was the Chief Invitee. She was accompanied by Dr Mrs Jyoti Salunkhe, Professor KINS. At the end Dr Vaishali Mohite addressed students and villagers. Being granddaughter of this village Khubi, villagers felicitated her in special. This evening programme was cared by Medical students.

Day 4 (Thursday 2<sup>nd</sup> March, 2017): Between 9:00am to 12:00noon the survey activity was undertaken. As knowledge about organ donation survey was over, Prevalence of hypertension survey was initiated. Students in the field were always under supervision of the staff. The afternoon lunch was served by Medical students. The arrangements and assistance of the afternoon activity 'Bones and Muscles diseases and Senior Citizens health Programme' was done by Physiotherapy and Nursing students. For the same the team of doctors was led by Dr Suraj Kanase and Dr Sandeep Shinde. They checked and advised/demonstrated physiotherapy exercises to 106 patients. In the evening there was a talk on adhyatmic subject 'Bharatiya Sanskruti: Kal v Aaj'. The arrangement for this activity was done by Dental students. The talk was delivered by Mr Anil Khatavakar, Principal Islampur High School and Junior College, Islampur. The talk was appreciated by all. Dr Varadarajulu, Principal KCPT was the Chief Invitee. He also addressed the audience at the end.

Day 5 (Friday 3rd March, 2017): The survey activity was carried out as usual between 9:00am to 12:00noon under guidance and supervision of the staff. The afternoon lunch was sponsored by Mr. Kuber (Appa) Mane, Dy. Sarpanch, Khubi. Physiotherapy students served the food. 'Estimation of Hb and Blood Group Investigation Programme' was organized in the afternoon for villagers. The arrangement and assistance for the same was extended by Medical students. Dr Sujata Kanetakar, Professor and Head Dept. of Pathology along with Dr Avinash Mane led the team of Pathologists. They examined and investigated 129 individuals. Those who were anemic, they were requested to visit Dept. of Pathology, KH for free in depth investigation. In the evening the philosophical talk was arranged. Arrangement of this programme was done by Physiology students. The talk on 'Swami Vivekanand' was delivered by Dr Shantanu Kulkarni, Professor and Head Dept. of Surgery, PIMS, Islampur. All were enthusiastic to hear the same. On hearing the same all found cheerful. Professor Nandkumar Kakade of KINS, Karad was Chief Guest for this programme.

Day 6 (Saturday 4<sup>th</sup> March, 2017): Students deed survey up to 10:00am. Further they were brought to visit Krishna Sugar Factory. They all observed functioning of the factory from sugar cane entry for crushing to production and feeling of sugar in bags. They understood hazardous situations of workers and talked with them about safety during the work. On the same day also visited Chouranginath Temple at Sonsal. After coming back to the Camp place and after lunch which was served by Nursing

Students, Physiotherapy students arranged for 'Handicap people's Programme'. The team of doctors led by Physiotherapist Dr Vaishali Jagatap visited houses of 6 handicapped individuals. They examined them and suggested exercises. These suggested exercises were demonstrated to them and were asked to exercise for appropriateness. These individuals were identified during survey activity by the student volunteers as they were instructed on the first day. As there was time for the next activity we all visited Ramdas Swami created Maruti mandir in the river Krishna at Bahe near Khubi. In the evening the speech on 'Khare-Khure Idols' was given by Mr Dilip Gaikwad, Teacher of Samaj Vikas Vidyalaya, Sagaon, Dist Sangli. The arrangement of this programme was done by Dental students. Dr Shashikiran, Principal, School of Dental Sciences, was the Chief Guest for this programme. This programme was continued for Valedictory of the NSS Special Camp. Dr Shashikiran was President for this function. Number of villagers talked their feelings about Camp activities. They appreciated all activities arranged during Camp. However, these all activities were planned by keeping students and villagers as center. Dr Shashikiran conveyed his feelings to students and villagers in Hindi which was also liked by the all. He during his presidential address promised villagers that he will do the needful to arrange a Camp to provide and fix dentures to the needy in concessional charges at Khubi, so that they will not be required to do extra expenses and also not to waste their time. All were happy as this service was required by them.

Day 7 (Sunday 5th March, 2017): This was the last day of the Camp. All surveys were completed by 12:00noon. Sarpanch, Dy. Sarpanch and some village leaders were invited for lunch. Dental and Nursing students served the food. After lunch Medical students made the provisions for 'General Health Programme'. Dr Makarand Mane led the team doctors for this programme. They examined 88 villagers and gave them required medicines. Students were not in mood as they were leaving Khubi today. By 5:00pm in the evening they took one round in the Khubi and placed in the College Bus. The Bus reached in KIMSDU Campus by 6:00pm. All staff and students, saying thanks to everyone, went their places.

During Camp all Officers, Mrs Sheela Kadam (KIMS), Dr Avinash Mane (KIMS), Dr S Anand (KCPT), Dr Keshav Abayya (SDS), Mr Shivaji Pawar (KINS) worked hard and a lot. The assistance of Dr Pranjali Gosavi (KCPT), Mr Nandakumar Kakade and Mrs Ujjwala More (KINS), Dr S K Danga and Mr Satish kambale





#### **NSS Special Camp**

The third NSS Special Camp was carried out in village Gondi, of Karad taluka for from Feb. 3 to 9, 2018. Fifty student volunteers from different disciplines (20 Medical, 10 Dental, 10 Nursing, and 10 Physiotherapy) participated in the Camp. They were informed about Camp activities in advance in their respective Institutes by their respective Programme Officer along with programme handouts. Following is day-to-day activities done in the Camp.

Day 1 (Saturday 3rd Feb., 2018): Students and staff started to Gondi by 8:30am and reached by 9:30am. Students, boys and girls, kept their material in allotted rooms and marched for 'Shivar-Pheri' to alert all villagers regarding initiation of the Camp activities by giving slogans and distributing programme schedule to villagers. On return they all gathered in Primary School which was taken as common place for all, staff and students. They were given tea and informed how to conduct the village socio-demographic survey. They were also advised to keep discipline throughout the Camp. The groups each of 5 students were formed to conduct the survey during seven days Camp period. A group of 5 students containing a student volunteer locally from village Gondi was specially formed to number the houses and to assist other groups. As it was 12:00noon, students were asked just to initiate survey activity by filling at least 3-4 survey forms. The staff also accompanied students during the survey. They returned by 1:00pm. By the time lunch was ready. Students from Physiotherapy faculty served food to all. Students from Medical faculty prepared for 'Child Health Programme'. The team of doctors led by Pediatrician Dr. Akshay Golwalkar arrived by 2:30pm for conduction of this activity. This team was assisted by Medical Students. The team checked 104 children and provided medicines as well as guided for further treatment to those needy. In the evening all students arranged for Camp Inauguration Programme. Hon'ble Dr. Suresh J. Bhosale; Chairman and Managing Trustee, Krishna Charitable Trust, Karad inaugurated this seven days special camp in presence of Dr Neelima Malik, Hon'ble Vice-Chancellor KIMSDU, Karad and Dr M. V. Ghorpade, Registrar KIMSDU, Karad. Sarpanch Mrs. Jaya Madane, Dy. Sarpanch Mr. Kishor Pawar, members of Gram Panchayat and villagers were present on this occasion. Dr. Suresh Bhosale briefed need of such activity in villages. He also informed students what things they can learn during this camp in the village. During this visit Hon,ble V.C. and Registrar directed us about students' safety and care.

Day 2 (Sunday 4th Feb., 2018): Survey conducted in the morning session from 9:00am to 12:00noon. The afternoon lunch served by medical students. From 3:00pm to 6:00pm 'Women Health Programme' was carried out. The team of doctors led by Dr Gauri Shinde and Dr Vrishali Ghorpade checked 89 women. Nursing students assisted the team. In the evening a talk on 'Samajik Janiva' delivered by Mrs. Pratibha Tamhankar, Ex Head Master of Kanya Shala Karad. Students, Staff and villagers encouraged and motivated to do something for the needy by her speech. An arrangement of this programme was done by Physiotherapy students. Dr Suraj Kanase, Phytherapy College was Chief Invitee for this evening programme.

Day 3 (Monday 5th Feb., 2018): The survey activity was carried out as usual during 9:00am to 12:00noon. Students were conducting this village survey with very much interest and also they were understanding the village culture as well as enjoying hospitality offered by them. Nursing students took the responsibility of serving the food. In the afternoon 'Bone and Muscle Diseases Programme' was arranged and assisted by Physiotherapy students. Dr Sandeep Shinde, Dr Javid Sagar and Dr Pranjali Gosavi led team of doctors for conducting this activity. They checked and advised/demonstrated physiotherapy exercises to 104 needy men and women. The evening programme was especially for public awareness. Mr Sudhir Kumbhar and Mr Kishor Darawade, together, presented on 'Andhsraddha Nirmulan: Kalachi Garaj'. They created awareness among all regarding how particular people misguide the layman by doing some magic. All were impressed by understanding science behind these magic. For this programme Prof. Nandkumar Kakade of KINS, Karad was the Chief Invitee. This evening programme was cared by Medical students.

Day 4 (Tusday 6<sup>th</sup> Feb., 2018): Between 9:00am to 12:00noon the survey activity was undertaken. Students in the field were always under supervision of the staff. Students those who were not involved in daily afternoon health programme activity, were conducting the survey. This resulted in completing the survey activity on 4<sup>th</sup> day of the Camp. The afternoon lunch was served by Medical students. The special lunch (feast) was given to all, students, staff and villagers (members of Gram-panchayat, local leaders and members of Ganesh Mandals). The arrangements and assistance of the afternoon activity 'Hb estimation and Blood Group identification Programme' was done by Medical students. For the same the team of doctors was led by Dr Sujata Kanetkar and Dr Avinash Mane along with senior technicians Mrs Karande and Mr Deepak Sahute. Total 124 villagers, men and women, took advantage of this

campaign. In the evening there was a talk on adhyatmic subject 'Bharatiya Sanskruti: Kal v Aaj'. The arrangement for this activity was done by Nursing students. The talk was delivered by Mr Anil Khatavakar, Principal Islampur High School and Junior College, Islampur. The talk was appreciated by all. Dr Mrs Geeta Karande, Professor and Head Microbiology Dept of KIMS was the Chief Invitee. She also liked and enjoyed this activity.

Day 5 (Wednesday 7th Feb., 2018): Since the survey activity was over, the visit to Krishna Sugar Factory was arranged. Students observed, learned and cleared their doubts regarding total process of sugar production. They understood hazardous situations of workers and talked with them about safety during the work. Nursing students served the afternoon food, 'ENT health checkup Programme' was organized in the afternoon for villagers. The arrangement and assistance for the same was extended by Physiotherapy students. Dr Sapana Shedage and Dr Sharmishtha Garud, ENT surgeons of KIMS conducted this activity. They examined and investigated 30 individuals. Some of them were requested to visit Dept. of ENT, KH for further treatment. In the evening the philosophical talk was arranged. Arrangement of this programme was done by Medical students. The talk on 'Mann Kara Re Prasanna' was delivered by Dr Shantanu Kulkarni, Professor and Head Dept. of Surgery, PIMS, Islampur. All were enthusiastic to hear the same. On hearing the same all found cheerful. Dr Shekhar Kumbhar of KIMS, Karad was Chief Guest for this programme. Day 6 (Thursday 8th Feb., 2018): In the morning session students visited Chouranginath Temple at Sonsal. After coming back to the Camp place Dental students served the lunch. The afternoon health programme 'Oral Health' was arranged by Dental students. The team of doctors led by Dr Keshav Abbayya along with Dr Apurva Kale and Dr Priyanka Kakade examined and treated 27 patients. They were given cards to take advantage of free/concessional treatment at Dental College, KIMSDU, Karad during three months period since the card given. In the evening the speech on 'Chhand Agala Vegala: Prani, Pakshi v Aapan' was given by Mr Shankar Kulkarni of RIT Islampur, Dist Sangli. Awareness campaign explaining need of use of toilets and practice to avoid open defecation, hygienic maintenance of toilets, maintenance of drinking water collection pots, cleanliness in and around the house, and frequent need of hand wash with demonstration of scientific method of hand wash was carried out in village Gondi by 40 student volunteers from nursing faculty. They were divided in 20 pairs and spread in the village. They educated families all above hygienic life aspects by paying house-to-house visits. After imparting the awareness they gifted one liquid hand wash to each of the visited family. Total 232 families were visited by these student volunteers.



#### Special Camp:Place - SHERE

NSS Special Camp of 7 days was organized in village Shere, Taluka Kardfrom Jan. 29 to Feb. 4, 2020. Sixty student volunteers; 15 Medical, 10 Dental, 11 Nursing, 11 Pharmcy and 13 Physiotherapy; participated in this Camp. They carried out the assigned activities under guidance of their faculty in-charge. Total 15 staff, teaching and non-teaching, supervised this Camp. Students served morning as well as evening tea and breakfast, and meals also. Dr Suresh Bhosale, Honorable Chancellor, KIMSDU; inaugurated the Camp. Day 1 (29 Jan., 2020): We all welcomed by Mr Balasaheb Nikam; Member Taluka Panchayat Samiti, Karad, Mrs. Surekha Gavade; Sarpanch Shere Grampanchayat, Mr Pandurang Nikam; Deputy Sarpanch; and Shere villagers at the camp sight, Primary School Shere. Activities carried out during the Camp started by conducting a rally in village for knowing the villagers regarding our arrival for conducting the Special Camp. After completing therally all students paid house-to-house visit to distribute the palm plate informing our 7 day schedule with requesting to participate in the scheduledactivities. In the afternoon students draw the village map through rangoli withassistance of villagers. This helped students to know the village in detail and also reminded villagers many more places that are not paid attention in routine life. In the evening Mr Rajiv Mohite, Ex Director Karad Urban Bank, talked on 'Jaganyasathi' He gave hints to students and villagers about howto remain happy and unstressful in day-to-day life. Dr Satish Ghatage, Principal Kakasaheb Chavhan Mahavidyalaya, Talamavale, talked on NSSobjectives and responsibilities of youth.

Day 2 (30 Jan., 2020): In this whole day students understood and learned importance, need and the manner of behaving during any kind of disaster. Mr Ashok Rokade, Convener of White Army, Kolhapur, NGO, with his team reached Camp site at 9:00am. This organization showed a VDO presenting various difficult locations and also places attacked by natural disaster. In theselocations and places how this team worked to encourage the people, how they launched safety measures to survive them from various disaster situations was displayed in the VDO. Students watched this VDO and impressed on their work performance. Further they demonstrated various emergency situations in which how one can help the needy without availability of any sophisticated health care material. They showed how to make a strature from available material, how to make ZULA using rope to carry the needy at difficult places like in hilly area, how to make JINA to climb or to get down for long distance using short rope, how to pump heart to restart it, etc. Further in the evening they demonstrated how to survive the people during flood with aid of small motor boat. They did this demo in river Krishna. All students learned these techniques.

Day 3 (31 Jan., 2020): A General Health Camp was organized in Mahadeo Mandir. Specialists from various disciplines like Medicine, Pediatric, Ob. Gyn., ENT, Orthopedic, Physiotherapy and Blood Bank participated in this Camp. All student volunteers assisted as well as learned from them clinical

Assessment, diagnosis, guidance and prescribing medicines. Total 217 needy villagers attended this Health Camp. In the evening Dr Shantanu Kulkarni, Professor and Head Dept of Surgery, Prakash Institute of Medical Sciences, Islampur talked on "Man Kara Re Prasanna". He took opportunity to communicate students regarding status of medical profession and ethics of practice. In the afternoon Dr D K Agarwal, Additional Director Research visited the Camp. He attended talk of Dr Shantanu Kulkarni and also advised students.

Day 4 (01/02/2020): After breakfast students marched in the village for performing VILLAGE SWACHHATA. They were with hard brooms, waste collecting pan and black bags. All streets of the village were cleaned by our students. They gathered waste and collected in the black plastic bag. This collected waste material was thrown at specified place by Shere Grampanchayat. During this activity they were doing conversation with villagers. Villagers were requesting them to not to do such work as you are guest. But our students performed this activity very sincerely. In the evening Dr Kishor Dharapade, Member of Maharashtra Andhashradhha Nirmulan Samiti, demonstrated various misguiding practices believed by people through a programme "Chala Dolas Hovuya!". He demonstrated how some typical people impresses layman as he/she is having god gifted speciality.

Day 5 (02/02/2020): On fifth day of the Camp, students were divided into groups; each of size 3. Since in these three days they were adjusted in this village, they were given freedom to select a house and stay for whole daywith members of that family. They were informed to maintain the discipline. They were also told to develop rapport with that family, find out their happyas well as sad facts, understand their life style, and identify their problems. After knowing all these and if any other matters, provide them guidance so that they could overcome any difficult situation. As per these directions they remained with 33 families for that day and helped them. As there was sad demise of an elder man, the evening programme was cancelled.

Day 6 (03/02/2020): The 'Mauli Pratishthan Group' a group of young enthusiastic villagers staying in Shere and staying outside due to their job, requested to participate in their SWACHHATA MISSION. Members of this group gather once in fortnight in village Shere and do some activity for the village. Our whole team whole heartedly participated in their activity and did as per their demand. The members were very happy for this cooperation. Our students also learned how villagers staying in and outside Shere are contributing for progress of their village. This was very great lesson for all of us. In the evening Dr Pravin Shingare, Hon'ble Pro-Chancellor, KIMSDU visited Camp along with Dr Mrs Rajani Gaonkar, CoE and Dr Mrs Sujata Jadhav, Professor Dept of Pharmacology, KIMS. He talked with students and shared his views about doctor's profession and expectations of society. Students shared with him their experiences during Camp. His visit encouraged our students and staff. Dr Nitin Shinde, Professor and Head Dept of Physics, KBP College Islampur further exemplified on 'Phal Jyotish: Samaj aani Vastav'. Hon'ble Pro-Chancellor attended this session. This lecture-cm-demo impressed all visitors, students, staff and villagers.

Day 7 (04/02/2020): On this last seventh day students found in failed mood as it was the day of termination of special camp. But they carried out the last day activity of creating awareness regarding importance of hand wash. They also
